Prerequisite classes offered at Alpena Community College (ACC) to be completed prior to admission into the Radiography Program are as follows:

The following General Education courses included in the shared Radiography curriculum are offered at ACC. It is recommended that they be completed prior to beginning the program.

Additionally, SSC 200 (Social Sciences and Contemporary America) are to be taken at Mid or equivalent credit earned.

For Anatomy and Physiology courses, a grade of "B-" or higher must be earned. Science courses must have been completed within five years of the date the student formally begins the program.

Students who have earned an Associates Degree from an accredited college have met the Mid General Education Level I requirements for English Composition, Fundamentals of Communications, and Algebra. Students who have earned a Bachelors Degree from an accredited college also have met General Education Level requirements as well as the Level II Social Sciences requirement.
